

The JMSC Internship Subsidy Programme

The JMSC faculty's networks with leading international media organizations have helped build one of the most dynamic journalism internship programmes in the world. This has provided both Bachelor of Journalism students with opportunities to intern within and outside Hong Kong.

The JMSC Internship Subsidy Programme seeks to:

- 1. Encourage and support the participation of BJ students in the journalism internship programme.
- 2. Make internships financially viable for students.

The JMSC will consider an internship subsidy to qualifying students who meet the application criteria.

Application Criteria

- 1. You must be a full-time student in the BJ programme.
- 2. You have already secured an unpaid internship which will last for a minimum of three weeks.
- 3. You have not received a JMSC internship subsidy before.
- 4. You must not be in receipt of any other internship grant or subsidy for the internship opportunity in question.

Application Process

Students may apply for up to HK\$3,000 for internship subsidy. Each student is entitled to apply for one internship subsidy for the duration of their BJ programme to allow as many students as possible to benefit from the JMSC Internship Subsidy Programme.

Application result will be announced by late September via email.

Successful candidates will be awarded by the SCMP Wah Kiu Yat Po Journalism Scholarship (or any other JMSC scholarship) and will be printed on your academic transcript. Subsidy will normally be deposited into your bank account by the year end.

Please make sure your bank account information in the HKU Portal is correct.

The funds available for the JMSC Internship Subsidy Programme and the maximum amount of subsidies will be determined annually by the JMSC. Applications will be reviewed on a rolling case-by-case basis. Subsidy awards will be made on a funds-available basis.

Enquiries and completed forms should be submitted to the JMSC office. Decisions will be notified by email.

Obligations of Subsidy Recipients

- 1. During the internship period, set up and maintain an internship blog that would be helpful and interesting to other students.
- 2. At the end of the internship, provide a summary report, a portfolio of published work during the internship and a completed internship evaluation form.
- 3. In addition, the recipient may be asked to speak in organized or informal settings to other students about their internship experience; attend any events organized with internship partners / sponsors / donors; and write an article on his / her internship experience.
